WHEREAS in the memory of Dr. Akhilesh Das Gupta, his wife Smt. Alka Das and son Viraj Sagar Das had been desirous of creating an educational trust; and

WHEREAS settlers/founders named above hereby establish a trust by name of 'Dr. Akhilesh Das Gupta Educational Trust' with the object and upon the terms detailed hereinafter:-

**1. Name of the Trust**

That the name of trust shall be 'Dr. Akhilesh Das Gupta Educational Trust'.

**2. Definition**

A. Trust would be mean Dr. Akhilesh Das Gupta Educational Trust.

B. Trustee - There would be three type of trustees namely:-

1. Founder Trustee
2. Permanent Trustee
3. Nominated Trustee.

**Founder Trustees** -Smt Alka Das and Sri Viraj Sagar Das are presently Founder Trustees and those who may be included as Founder Trustees as per clause 7 would also be Founder Trustee.

**Permanent Trustees** - Founder Trustees would be permanent Trustees. Further Trustees to be nominated by the Founder Trustees as permanent Trustees as per Clause 7 would also be permanent Trustees.

**Nominated Trustees** - Persons to be nominated by Founder Trustees as Nominated Trustees as per clause 7 would be Nominated Trustees.



Total number of Trustees inclusive of Founder Trustees, Permanent Trustees (other than Founder Trustees) and Nominated Trustees shall not exceed 4 (Four).

**3A. Initial Corpus of Trust**

The founders/permanent trustees have this day contributed Rs. 1,00,000/- (Rs one lakh) each towards initial corpus of trust. At present there is no immovable property involved in the trust so created.

**3B. Trust Property:**

The Trust Property shall comprise of the said initial Trust Fund as well as all other amounts, securities, properties movables or immovables, which may be contributed or donated by the Founders, Members of the Public or anyone else or from any other source and shall also include all additions, accretions, and acquisitions made by the trust and the income received by the Trust from time to time. Trust property shall vest in the Trustees, herein upon Trust, subject to the provisions hereof for the due fulfillment of the objects of the Trust.

**4. Office of the Trust:**

The principal office of the Trust shall be at 55, Purana Qila Lucknow, Lucknow-226001, which



can be shifted to any other place with the mutual consent of the Founder Trustees.

5. **Nature of the Trust:**

This Trust shall be a Public Charitable Trust having no commercial or profit motives, It shall be maintained and administered to promote education, medical relief, running of the Kalyan Mandap, for the benefit of the weaker sections of public, a home for physically handicapped and any other objects of general public in India without any distinction. The Trust Property including its funds and income shall be applied solely towards promotion of the objects for which this Trust is established.

6. **Objects of the Trust:-**

The aims and objects of the Trust are as follows:-

- a. To create, establish and maintain a cadre of selfless and devoted workers for social economical, educational, cultural and political uplift of the people.
- b. To eradicate the social evils, un-educated, poverty and other factors that retard the general development of humanitarian, irrespective of races sex, colour and creed.



- c. To work for national integration and economic uplift of the nation and to revise and develop ancient culture and heritage of India.
- d. To promote diffusion of knowledge and spreading the all kind of education and maintain, libraries, Museums and holding intellectual gatherings with a view to exchange of knowledge pertaining to various intellectual happenings, openings of educational Institution etc.
- e. To promote scientific inventions and discoveries and information technology, which would result in betterment of mankind.
- f. To open, help and assist Medical, Dental, Pharmacist, Nursing, Engineering, Management Courses and Dispensaries and Clinics for imparting free or subsidized medical aid to lesser privileged Class or Society and to work for medical health environmental awareness and population control.
- g. To arrange for mental and physical recreation of the financially lesser able persons by holding sports and games, competitions, arranging film shows and organizing dramatic activities.
- h. To publish journals, news paper whether daily/weekly/fortnightly, periodicals and Books with an effort to enlighten the mankind.



- i. To send and receive members abroad in order to spread our cultural achievements and adopt what is better in our counter parts.
- j. To promote and propagate village/cottage industries with a view to create employment and eradicate poverty.
- k. To develop the democratic and patriotic traits in the society.
- l. To work for the upliftment of down trodden class and other oppressed constituents of the society.
- m. To establish, maintain and aid charitable institutions such as Dharamshalas, Sarais, Gaushalas, Maternity Homes, Child Welfare Centers, Poor Houses, Orphanages Institution for Blinds, Houses for old and infirm people, Widow Houses, Training centers, Public Halls, Rescue Homes and other similar Institutions/organization.
- n. To establish maintain and aid religious Spiritual educational institutions in general.
- o. To establish and maintain an institution for aviation technology & Flying training Academy for down trodden class and other oppressed caste as per Central/State Government Norms.
- p. To help and promote the continuous supply of Electricity, sufficient supply of safe drinking



- water and to educate public for sanitation for down trodden class and other constituents of society.
- q. Sustainable exploitation of salt affected waste lands into fertilized land.
  - r. To take up any activity, considered suitable and in conformity with the law of the land and the need of the day.
  - s. To takeover, manage or combine, whether by affiliation or otherwise, with any other Institution for the furtherance of all or any of its object.
  - t. To put up regional centers and sub-centers of the society. Wherever it may deem fit in order to promote its objectives.
  - u. To establish, run, support, develop, maintain and grant aid in cash or in kind to hospitals, medical, schools, medical, colleges, nursing institutions, libraries, universities laboratories dispensaries, maternity homes, child welfare centers research or other institution of like nature for use of the students and the staff and also for the development and advancement of education and diffusion of knowledge amongst the public in general.
  - v. To establish, maintain and run studentships, scholarships and render other kind of aid to



- students including supply of books, stipends, medals and other incentives to study, without any distinction as to caste, colour, race, creed or sex.
- w. To promote, establish, support maintain or grant aid to institutions for the promotion or science, literature, music, drama and fine arts, for the preservation of historical monuments and for the research and other institutions, in India, having similar objects for the benefit of the public in general.
  - x. To establish, maintain or grant aid for the establishment and/or maintenance of parks, gardens, gymnasiums, sports, clubs, dharamshalas and rest houses, for use by public in general.
  - y. To establish maintain or grant aid to homes for the aged, orphanages or other establishments for the relief and help to the poor, needy and destitute people, orphans, widows and aged persons.
  - z. To establish and develop institutions for the physically handicapped and disables or mentally retarded persons and to provided them education, food, clothing or other help.



- aa. To grant relief and assistance to the needy victims during natural calamities such as famine, earth quake, flood, fire, pestilence etc. and to give donations and other assistance to institutions, establishments or persons engaged in such relief work.
- bb. To construct, repair and manage the marghats, cemeteries and burial grounds.

7. **Management of Trust:-**

This Trust shall be administered by a Board of Trustees consisting of Founder Trustees, Permanent Trustees and Nominated Trustees.

Founder Trustees with majority decision shall have right to nominate and appoint any of the lineal descendent of Late Dr. Akhilesh Das Gupta and spouse of male lineal descendant of Late Dr. Akhilesh Das Gupta as Founder Trustee.

Founder Trustees with majority decision shall have right to nominate and appoint Permanent Trustees, in case majority decision, concurrence of the Chairman is must. Further Chairman shall have casting vote in case of tie.

Founder Trustees with majority decision shall have right to nominate and appoint Nominated Trustees for the maximum period of 3 years at a time. in case majority decision, concurrence of the



Chairman is must. Further Chairman shall have casting vote in case of tie.

Total number of Trustees inclusive of Founder Trustees, Permanent Trustees and Nominated Trustees at any time shall not exceed four.

Nominated Trustee can be reappointed for any number of times for period of three years each. He/she can also be appointed/ nominated for the lesser period.

Where ever appointment of Founder Trustee, Permanent Trustee or Nominated Trustee is made by majority decision, the concurrence of the Chairman is must.

The Trustees shall elect among themselves office bearers, consisting of Chairman, Secretary, Treasurer etc. as per the requirement for smooth functioning of the Trust affairs.

There shall be a Chairman for the administration of the trust, nominated by the board of Trustees, who shall be one amongst Founder trustees.

The Trustees shall elect the Treasurer and Secretary or Treasurer from among themselves once in 3 years. The routine administration of the Trust, its property and affairs, convening meetings of the Trustees, maintaining minutes, accounts, records and other documents, of the

Trust shall be looked after by the Chairman of the Board of Trustees.

Mrs. Alka Das shall be Chairman for her lifetime and she cannot be removed in any event. However she can make Viraj Sagar Das Chairman of the Trust during her lifetime, who (Viraj Sagar Das) shall on nomination by Smt. Alka Das will become Chairman for his lifetime. Further Sri Viraj Sagar Das shall also during his lifetime can make any Founder Trustee as Chairman.

It is made clear that the Chairman of the Trust and the Chairman of the Board of Trustees is one and the same thing.

In the event of death of Smt. Alka Das-Chairman (Founder Trustee), Sri Viraj Sagar Das-Secretary-cum-Trustee (Founder Trustee) shall become Chairman and other Founder Trustee if any at that time would become Treasurer Cum Secretary of the Trust. In the absence of any other Founder Trustee at the relevant time, any of the Permanent Trustee to be nominated by the Founder Trustee would become Treasurer-cum-Secretary of the Trust. If considered proper separate persons amongst the founder trustees be appointed as Treasurer and Secretary
